2024 Tournament Notice to Players

- The format is Gross Stableford/Quota
- One **preprinted scorecard** for entire foursome will be provided.
- A player from **each cart** must keep all scores (one official card, one scorecard from course) for the Foursome. After the round **REPORT TO THE SCORERS TABLE** compare hole by hole and attest scorecard with two (2) signatures.
- Only the preprinted scorecard will be accepted for official scoring for the entire foursome. **Please do not go to your car first!**
- **Do not post your own scores into GHIN. Committee will post each round.**

Flights, Pairing and Tee Box:

- Players are divided into 6 flights of 14 players in each flight
- There are three **Divisions, (2 flights in each Division) which are used for SKINS only**
- **All Flights will play from the same tee boxes established by the tournament committee:**
 - **Steele Canyon -Vineyards/Ranch** Gold Tees
 - **Steele Canyon - Canyons/Ranch** Gold Tees
 - **Maderas** Blue Tees
 - **Aviara** White/Gold Combo Tees
 - **The Grand** Green Tees

Scoring:

- Record the **gross score** for each player on each hole.
- **For pace of play you must pick up** if you are putting for an **8** on a **par 3** | **9** on a **par 4** | **10** on a **par 5**.
 - If you pick up before holing out, record what you think you would have received along with an "X" in the box for that hole. Golf Genius will convert to Stableford scoring as well as run Skins.

The Stableford Points earned on each hole are:

Triple Bogey or worse (Gross)	0 points
Double Bogey	1 points
Bogey	2 points
Par	3 points
Birdie	4 points
Eagle (or HIO on a Par 3)	5 points

Stableford Quota Payouts:

- Each Flight will have a minimum of 50% of the field win \$\$ **daily**.
- There will be **overall** weekly winners for each flight receives a crystal medallion.
- One **overall** winner and runner-up for the entire field will receive the annual Champion and Runner Up Crystal award

Daily Competition:

- **Stableford Quota: Daily and full week, by flight.** Champion and runner-up by entire field.

- **Skins (Gross & Net):** by three divisions | Division 1 (Flights 1 & 2) | Division 2 (Flights 3 & 4) | Division 3 (Flights 5 & 6)
- **Closest to the Pin:** On 3 of the Par 3's by **Flight**, **Make sure you know your FLIGHT!**
We are providing our own tape measures. The first group on a par 3 (may be asked to take out the tape measure and Markers) The last group will be asked to pick up the markers, and tape measures.
- **Casino Hole:** Each day, one of the Par 3's will have a 15' string placed near the marker card. If your ball is within the string, write your name on the board. \$100.00 will be split with every name inside the 15' string (entire field)
- **Hole-in-one bonus:** **Each day** there will be a \$100.00 cash bonus for an ace made on that designated par 3.
- **Deuce Pot:** ANY natural 2 on ANY hole, shares, or wins the daily pot. (\$192.00-Entire field)
If a hole-in-one is made on any hole that Ace will automatically win 1/2 of the entire deuce pot, leaving the other 1/2 to be split amongst any deuces. If there are no "deuces" made, the pot carries over to the next day! If none on Friday, it will be added to KP pot per flight.

Playing Rules:

- The USGA Rules of Golf govern all play unless otherwise noted.
- Please review the **local course rules on the back of scorecard**
- **Fairway divot rule:** Free relief 6", no closer to the hole, if ball lands in a fairway divot otherwise play the ball as it lies.
- **For pace of play you must pick up** if you are putting for an **8** on a **par 3**, **9** on a **par 4**, **10** on a **par 5** or if **you want to concede that hole**. Put X and what you would have received if finished
- Any rules questions or disputes that arise during the round **must** be referred to the committee **prior** to turning in your scorecard.
- A player in doubt as to her rights under the Rules or how to proceed may play a second ball under rule 20.1c(3). Announce your intention to do so and which ball will be scored if the rules allow before playing either ball. Notify the committee you played two balls upon completion of the round prior to turning in the card.
- **EACH FOURSOME MUST** come to the scorer's table to attest scores and review any rules issues that arose during play.

Monday, November 04

Steele Canyon –Ranch/Vineyard

The Official Scorecard is reflected as holes #1 - #18.

Please remember that #1-#9 is RANCH | #10-#18 is VINEYARD.

RANCH:

#2 Drop Zone – If Tee shot does not make it over the native area, there is a drop zone on the other side, left of the cart path before fairway.

#4 on approach to the green, if your ball does not make it over the native area, you may drop on the other side (on the same line you entered and would have exited) for a 2-stroke penalty. You always have the option of playing the drop from the point of entry for 1-stroke.

VINEYARD (#10-#18)

#15 Drop zone - On approach to the green, you may drop on the other side at the drop area as soon as you come around to the fairway after area. Use Drop area for a 2-stroke penalty. You always have the option of playing the drop from the point of entry for 1-stroke

Tuesday, November 05

Steele Canyon –Canyon/Ranch

The Official Scorecard is reflected as holes #1 - #18.

Please remember that #1-#9 is CANYON and #10-#18 is RANCH

CANYON (#1-#9)

#4 Drop Zone – If Tee shot does not make it over the native area, there is a drop zone at the Red Tee Box.
(DO NOT TEE UP BALL)

#7 Drop Zone - If Tee shot does not make it over the native area, there is a drop zone, right of the cart path left of the green

RANCH (#10-#18)

#11 Drop Zone – If Tee shot does not make it over the native area, there is a drop zone on the other side, left of the cart path before fairway.

#13 If your ball does not make it over the native area, you may drop on the other side (on the same line you entered) for a 2-stroke. You always have the option of playing the drop from the point of entry for 1-stroke

Wednesday, November 06

Maderas

#2 – left of hole 2 is a lateral hazard. Unless you cross the fence line into the homes which is out of bounds.

#6- drop zone is across the native area on the left hand side of the fairway. There is a tee box labeled drop zone. **DO NOT TEE IT UP**

#7- drop zone is located across the hazard short of front right bunker.

#15- drop zone is at the bottom of the hill after the tee box, to the left of the cart path, labeled drop zone.

#17- drop zone is to the right of the green by the bridge.

#17 - Drop zone is located the next tee box RED - **DO NOT TEE IT UP!**
